



Red River Valley Speedway Rules of Conduct

- 1. No beer or alcoholic beverages may be consumed in the pit area until the entire race is completed for all classes. Anyone caught drinking in the pits before the races are complete will be immediately ejected from the premises. No mood altering drugs are allowed on the premises at any time and no one under the influence of such drugs will be allowed on the property.**
- 2. Any person(s) who cause a disturbance on the race premises may be suspended from ALL race events for 2 weeks. He/She will forfeit all points and money for the night. Drivers are responsible for their crew members.**
- 3. No driver or crew member shall subject any track employee, official, other driver(s), or crew members to any abuse or improper language (including improper gestures) at any time. Any driver who assaults (verbally or otherwise) or threatens any of the above mentioned parties may be suspended for a period of 2 weeks and will forfeit any points or money for that night.
RRVS reserves the right to increase this punishment to the maximum allowed under WISSOTA rules depending on the severity of the infraction under section 1.11 of the WISSOTA rulebook.**
- 4. Drivers will be the sole spokesperson for his/her car. This means that is you have a question, the driver is the only person to talk to the officials about the problem. NOT the pitmen, car owner, or relatives, ect.**
- 5. NO ONE stops on the race surface to discuss incidents or calls with any official. No one may enter the flagging area (secured area near flagstand) to speak with the flagmen about incidents or calls without the express approval of RRVS staff.**
